Registering Students:

- 2. There are three (3) methods for adding students to BravoMe:
 - a. Give your students a web address to which they'll go and register on their own (for students ages 13 and older).
 - b. Enter your students' ID numbers, first names and last initials only, and BravoMe will create accounts for them (for students ages 8-17).
 - Upload a class list with first names and last initials, and BravoMe will automatically create accounts for your students (for students ages 8-17).
- 3. Give your students their login information after registering, and they will now have access to BravoMe.com. (Note: students under 13 will have to have their parents complete the process with them, as required by law).

SAFETY CONCERNS

Unlike open social networking sites (such as Myspace, Friendster, and Bebo), BravoMe.com is a <u>closed</u> network, designed for teachers, students and parents only.

How do we limit who gets access? It's simple. It starts with the teacher. By registering and verifying your teacher status using your school email address, we know that you are a legitimate member of a school. Since you make the student accounts yourself, we know the students are indeed students. Parents get linked to their own children, but only through the student account that you, the teacher, created. No one from the outside world can see profiles or information on any children. Even once parents are linked, they can only view their child's information.
